BALDWIN COUNTY ORTHOPAEDIC DOCTOR PARTICIPATES IN ANNUAL MEDICAL MISSION IN ECUADOR TO PROVIDE SHOULDER AND KNEE SURGERIES TO THOSE IN UNDERDEVELOPED COUNTRIES

DAPHNE, Ala. (*April 5, 2016*)-- Dr. John Todd, a local orthopedic surgeon with Baldwin Bone & Joint, P.C. since 2000, recently joined a local medical team on a mission trip to benefit those in need of orthopedic surgery in Ecuador.

Todd, a fellowship trained sports medicine physician and shoulder surgeon, recently traveled to Coastal Ecuador in South America as part of a local brigade of surgeons, nurses and physician assistants to participate in an orthopedic surgical mission. The project is an ongoing effort sponsored by Bayside Medical Missions, a 501c charitable organization based in Fairhope, AL. While in Ecuador the team performed 30 orthopedic surgical procedures including ACL reconstructions of the knee, shoulder reconstructions, total hip replacements and revision surgeries of old traumatic injuries.

The surgeries were performed at the La Vida Surgery Center (https://www.facebook.com/Bayside-Medical-Missions-118286941563538/?fref=ts), a two-operating room, state-of-the-art outpatient surgery center that is made possible through the collaboration between <u>Bayside Medical Missions</u>, <u>Samaritan's Purse</u> and the <u>Christian and Missionary Alliance Church</u>.

Bayside Medical Missions began traveling to underdeveloped countries 38 years ago providing surgical interventions- focusing on Ecuador in 2000. Todd has participated in three of these these medical mission trips since 2012.
